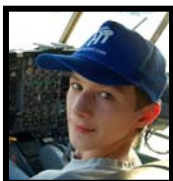

**\$3,000 Pilot Certificate Scholarship**— awarded to an aviation Explorer pursuing their recreational or private pilot certificate (any type aircraft) and is not restricted to those pursuing a career in aviation. Flight training must be completed within one year. Candidates are judged on the strength of their essay stating their plan for a career in aviation, evidence of satisfactory initial flight training, and performance history in education and/or work, volunteerism, financial need.
