If your council chooses not to renew the Intellectual Property License Agreement, please sign and check the box in the area where it says, *Council will NOT renew*.

If you have a special circumstance that may require extra time to return this agreement, please let us know, and we will work with you.

Please notice that your signed license agreement will be valid from (August 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026. The lump sum ACH payment must be made within the fiscal year 2026 (between the dates of January 1, 2026, through January 31, 2026). ### Learning for Life Curriculum-Based books have been updated and are now available:

Councils must have a current license agreement for the right to use or sell all LFL products.

Champions "Special Needs", Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> Grade, 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade, 4<sup>th</sup> Grade, 5<sup>th</sup> Grade, 6<sup>th</sup> Grade, 7<sup>th</sup> Grade, and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade books are now available.

We anticipate the High School Curriculum Book that covers grades 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> to be released by the end of September 2025.

We will now provide PDF versions of the newly updated books to you at no additional charge, and you may also print the books locally at a printer of your choice.

In addition, we have secured a vendor for a "print on demand option" when you have the need for printed books.
